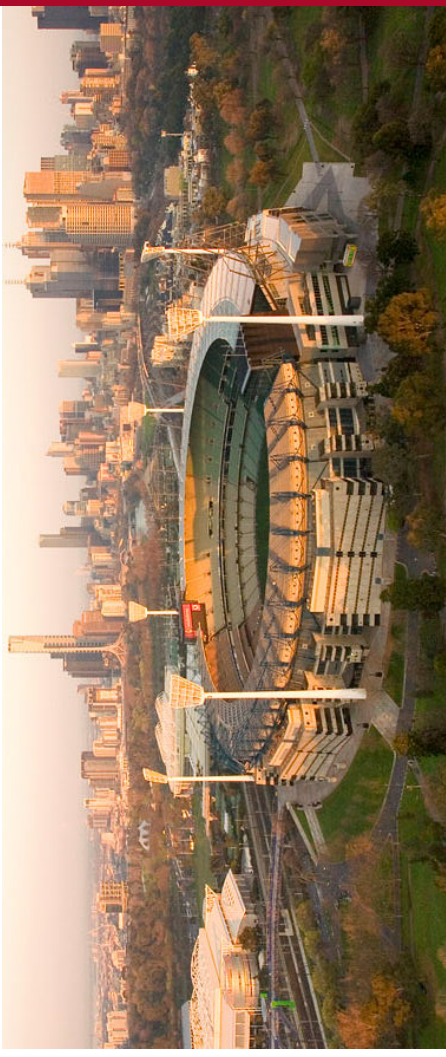

When we look back at the history of St Margaret's there are some important moments that defined the future of the School. Certainly the move to Berwick was a key one, chosen with the safety of students during the war years in mind. More recently our new facilities such as the Auditorium, Food Technology Centre, Junior School Library, classrooms, playground and Sports Pavilion have certainly had an impact on the opportunities we can offer to our students.

However, one of the most significant strategic directions of the School has been the creation of a boys' campus of St Margaret's: **Berwick Grammar School (BGS)**. Our dual campus model secures our future for both boys and girls education and creates a myriad of opportunities to enhance student learning and socialization.

And so we announce to our community a Foundation Ball in honour of the commencement of Berwick Grammar School in 2009. This celebration is for our whole community and we have secured the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) as the venue for this special event. The last major community celebration was for St Margaret's 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and the response from families was that it was an outstanding event. The same, very popular musical band has been secured and we expect to dance the night away once again.

We have decided to let everyone know early so they can plan ahead in terms of a table of friends, making sure the diary entry is made, ticket purchased and all necessary arrangements in place.
